controlling the production, differentiation, and function of 2 related white cell populations of the blood,

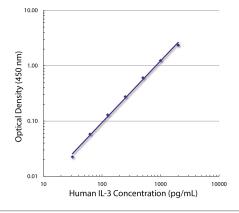
the granulocytes and the monocytes-macrophages.
