Storage instruction	For continuous use, store undiluted antibody at 2-8°C for up to a week. For long-term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Storage in frost free freezers is not recommended. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Suggest spin the vial prior to opening. The antibody solution should be gently mixed





Gene Full Name	RAB39A, Member RAS Oncogene Family / RAB39B, Member RAS Oncogene Family
Background	Predicted to enable GTPase activity. Involved in phagosome acidification and phagosome-lysosome fusion. Located in phagocytic vesicle. [provided by Alliance of Genome Resources, Apr 2022]
Function	Plays a role in the maturation and acidification of phagosomes that engulf pathogens, such as S.aureus and M.tuberculosis. Plays a role in vesicular trafficking. Plays a role in the fusion of phagosomes with lysosomes. Negatively regulates LPS-induced autophagosome formation in macrophages possibly by implicating PI3K.


ARG43876 anti-RAB39A/B antibody WB image
