before use.

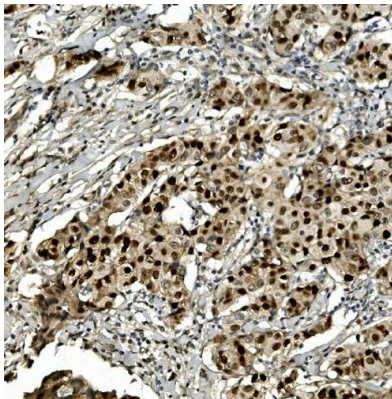

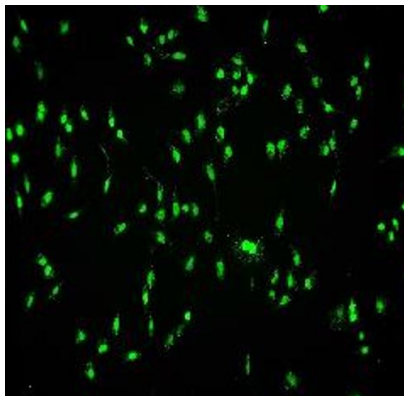

Background	This gene encodes a thiamine-dependent enzyme which plays a role in the channeling of excess sugar phosphates to glycolysis in the pentose phosphate pathway. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding multiple isoforms have been observed for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Apr 2012]
Function	Catalyzes the transfer of a two-carbon ketol group from a ketose donor to an aldose acceptor, via a covalent intermediate with the cofactor thiamine pyrophosphate. [UniProt]. [UniProt]

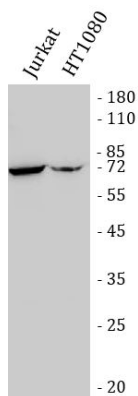

Immunohistochemistry: Human mammary cancer stained with ARG45424 anti-TKT antibody at 1 µg/ml dilution.



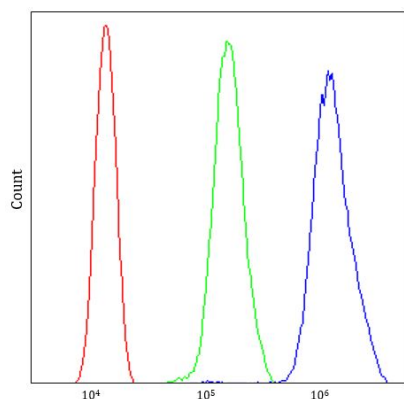
ARG45424 anti-TKT antibody ICC/IF image

Immunofluorescence: A549 stained with ARG45424 anti-TKT antibody at 4 µg/ml dilution.



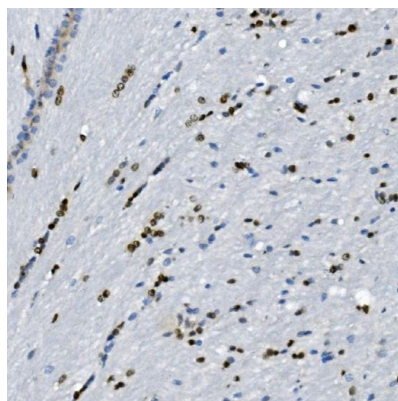

Western blot: Jurkat and HT1080 stained with ARG45424 anti-TKT antibody at 0.5 µg/ml dilution.



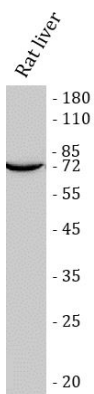

Flow Cytometry: THP-1 stained with ARG45424 anti-TKT antibody at 1 µg/10⁶ cells dilution.



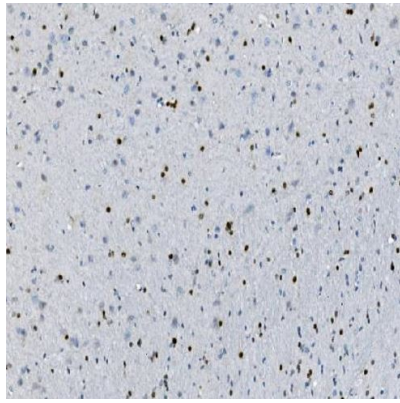

Immunohistochemistry: Rat brain stained with ARG45424 anti-TKT antibody at 1 µg/ml dilution.



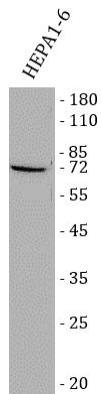
